Subject: Electronic Sticker Implementation Date

In August of 2007, the North Carolina General Assembly passed House Bill 679, which has an implementation date of October 1, 2008. The North Carolina Division of Motor Vehicles' new electronic vehicle inspection program will go online November 1, 2008, one month after the original October 1 launch date, to allow additional time to receive and install computers and software throughout the state. The cost of safety-only vehicle inspection is still scheduled to increase from \$9.10 to \$13.60 on October 1, 2008. During the month of October, you are to continue to use inspection stickers, and will still be able to purchase them at your local NCDMV Tag Agency.

Enclosed, you will find a Memorandum of Understanding, which addresses the use of the electronic inspection equipment that will be deployed to your business. This document must be reviewed and signed by the station owner/operator. The original copy must be presented to the DMV representative that comes to your station to activate the new inspection equipment..
